

This is me pocket dice inserts

By sliding different inserts into the pockets of your dice you can play a variety of games and activities to practise the language modelled in App 1: *This is me*.

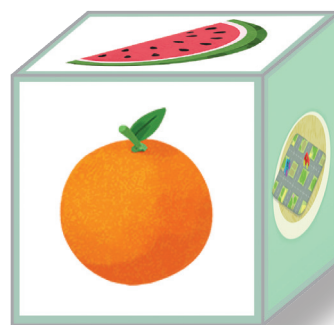
This set of inserts includes images of 11 fruits and 7 activity stations.

Steps to use these printable images

1. Cut out the cards.
2. Choose 6 fruits or 6 activity stations to insert into your dice.
3. You can practise the language of preferences in large- or small-group experiences.
4. Roll the dice and model the language for the children.
5. Ask a child to roll the dice and make a statement about their preferences of what they've rolled using sentence starters such as 'I like...','I don't like...','I want...' or 'I love...'

For example:

- I like apples.
- I like to paint.
- I don't like bananas.
- I don't like to dance.
- I love pineapple.
- I love to play with cars.
- I really don't like chilli.
- I really don't like to dress up.
- I want some watermelon.
- I want to cook.
- I don't want strawberries.
- I don't want to play music.
